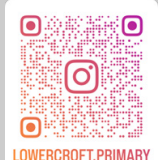
Introducing ERICC's Before and After School Club

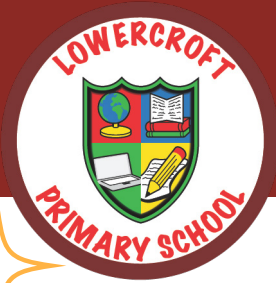

We are incredibly proud to share the amazing work of Ethan Bunnell, one of our Year 6 pupils, who has designed and created our fantastic new outdoor classroom!

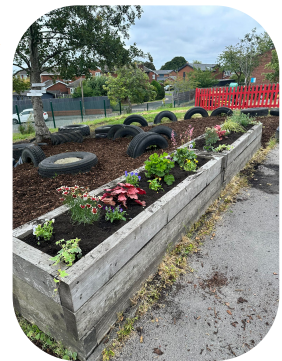
