Getting Ready for September

Children born between 1st September 2021 and 31st August 2022 will be eligible to start in our Reception class in September 2026.

We are also offering daytime tours of the school. As pupils will be in class, we kindly ask parents to pre-book these tours. This keeps groups small to minimise disruption and ensures everyone has the opportunity to visit.

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Places

Notification of Places

Notification of places will be sent out by the Schools Admissions Team on 16th April 2026. After this date, we will write to all parents of children who have been offered a place at Lowercroft with more information about starting school.

Getting Ready for September

We will hold an Information Evening in June for parents, which will cover all the day to day practical details you will need to know before your child starts school with us in September. There will be an opportunity for our new Reception pupils to visit school and meet their teachers in July 2026. We also offer optional home visits, which will take place during the first week of the autumn term.

September 2026

School reopens after the summer break on Thursday 3rd September. Reception pupils will start school on Friday 4th September 2026 and will attend either morning or afternoon. From Monday 7th September, they will attend school full time from 8.45am until 3.10pm.
