As part of our celebrations for **British Science Week 2026** next week, we are inviting all children to take part in the **national British Science Week Poster Competition**.

This year's theme, "Curiosity: What's Your Question?", explores what makes a positive future for young people. Children are invited to think about and respond to the following:

- "What makes children's lives good?"
- "What makes children's lives positive?"
- "What will a positive childhood look like in the future for children your age?"

These questions aim to spark curiosity and encourage children to share their own ideas about what contributes to a happy, healthy, positive childhood. The national organisers are working with scientists and researchers who want to understand young people's visions for a good/positive childhood.
