On Thursday after school, our Year 6 pupils will be putting their entrepreneurial skills to the test as they sell the products they have created as part of their annual Enterprise Project. The project begins with pupils working in teams to develop a business idea before presenting their plans in a Dragon's Den-style pitch. Each team must explain their product, marketing strategy and how they plan to make a profit. Following their presentations, the PTA invests £5 into each business to help them get started. The teams then take responsibility for purchasing materials, making their products and organising the sale. Their challenge is simple: make as much profit as possible! Along the way, they learn valuable skills including teamwork, budgeting, communication and problem-solving. We were delighted that Sarah from the PTA was able to join us to listen to the presentations and make the all-important investment decisions. We are very grateful for her support, especially as Alan Sugar was unfortunately unavailable! The children have worked incredibly hard and produced some fantastic ideas.
