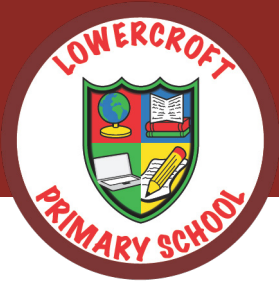
**Celebrating
