**Get your mixing bowls ready – The Great Lowercroft Bake Off is on its way!**

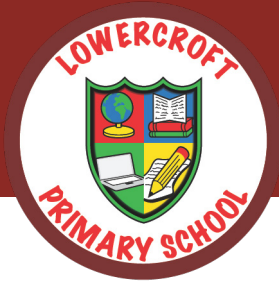
