## Temporary Access Change for Jay Jay's - 11th-13th June

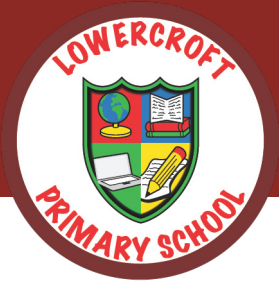
